(October 4, 2020)

Jesus Enters Jerusalem

Background Passage Luke 19:28-48

- Point 1. Jesus is the Messiah who receives praise from His people (Luke 19:35-40)**
- Point 2. Jesus is the Messiah who weeps for His people (Luke 19:41-44)**
- Point 3. Jesus is the Messiah who restores true worship through His people (Luke 19:45-46)**

(October 11, 2020)

Jesus is Questioned

Background Passage Mark 12:13-40

- Point 1. Jesus teaches the reality of resurrection from God's Word (Mark 12:19-27)**
- Point 2. Jesus teaches the primacy of love from God's Word (Mark 12:28-34)**
- Point 3. Jesus teaches the deity of the Messiah from God's Word (Mark 12:35-37)**

(October 18, 2020)

Jesus Shares the Lord's Supper

Background Passage Luke 22:7-23

- Point 1. The Lord's Supper anticipates a kingdom in the future (Luke 22:14-18)**
- Point 2. The Lord's Supper remembers a sacrifice in the past (Luke 22:19)**
- Point 3. The Lord's Supper pictures a new covenant in the present (Luke 22:20-23)**

(October 25, 2020)

Jesus is Arrested

Background Passage Mark 14:27-15:5

- Point 1. Jesus affirms the will of the Father (Mark 14:32-36)**
- Point 2. Jesus affirms the plan foretold in Scripture (Mark 14:43-49)**
- Point 3. Jesus affirms His identity as Messiah (Mark 14:53, 60-64)**

(November 1, 2020)

Jesus is Crucified

Background Passage Mark 15:6-47

- Point 1. Jesus is the rejected Savior of the world (Mark 15:6, 11-15)**
- Point 2. Jesus is the mocked King of kings (Mark 15:16-20)**
- Point 3. Jesus is the forsaken Son of God (Mark 15:33-39)**
